
| Big Duncan Room sizes | |



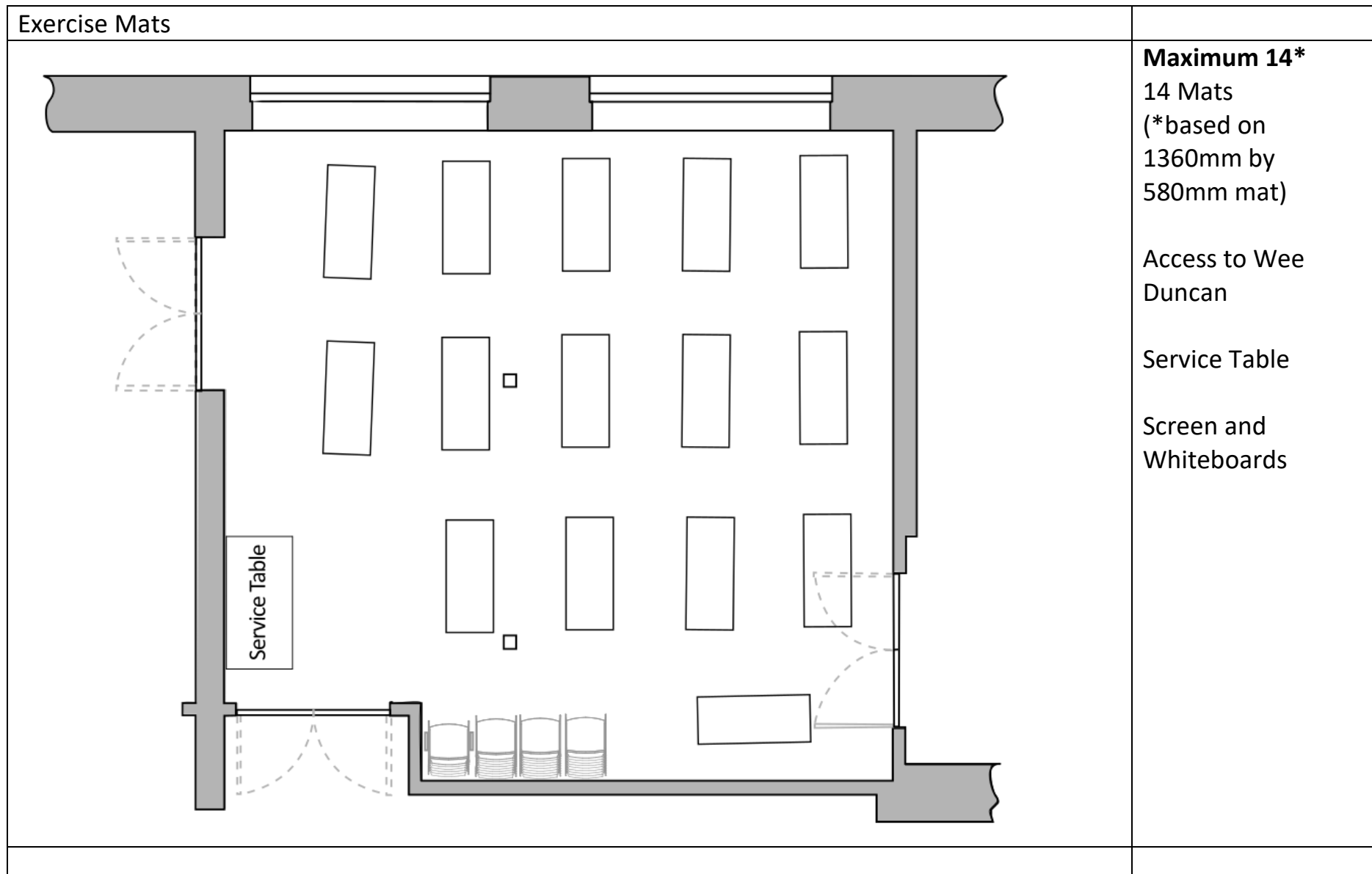
